



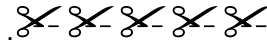

Learn the importance of citing your sources from veteran researcher Charlotte Bocage and how to do it.



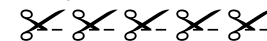
**WHEN: Saturday, July 15, 2017 11 am – 12:30 pm

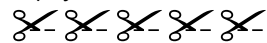
**WHEN: Saturday, August 19, 2017 11 am – 12:30 pm
