Park UNDER the library, enter at 524 Flower St. just south of 5th Street. You need a LAPL card to receive the \$1.00 Saturday parking rate. Apply for the card at your local LAPL or at the Circulation Desk when you arrive or leave. Just bring identification. Show your library card to get your parking ticket validated at the Information Desk before returning to your car. Take the escalator or elevator down to Lower Level 4. Inquire at the main reference desk for our location. Please travel light. This is a public building—it is NOT recommended that you leave computers, purses or other personal items unattended while researching.
