

2 GENEALOGICAL LIBRARIES JOIN BIG COLLECTIONS

The Southern California Genealogy Society has merged its library with that of the Sons of the Revolution. The result is one of the largest privately owned genealogical libraries in the United States.

New location for this joint effort, which will open Tuesday is 600 S. Central Ave. (at Chestnut), Glendale.

The past six months have seen remodeling of the building and it is now one of the most modern libraries. Close to 25,000 books will be housed inside.

Hours for the library are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Wednesday hours will be 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. The library is open to the public and will feature qualified personnel to assist patrons. The telephone number is 247-1620.
